8	(b) A school district shall excuse a student from attending

12	(A) observing religious holy days; [or]

14	(C) spending time with the student's parent, if

16	returning from deployment to a combat zone as a member of the armed
17	forces of the United States, a reserve component of the armed forces
18	of the United States, or the state military forces; or
19	(2) a temporary absence resulting from health care
20	professionals if that student commences classes or returns to
21	school on the same day of the appointment.
22	(b-1) The board of trustees of each independent school

- 2 (e) In this section, "combat zone" means an area that the
- 3 president of the United States by executive order designates for
- 4 purposes of 26 U.S.C. Section 112 as an area in which armed forces
- 5 of the United States are or have engaged in combat.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
