A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to school bus emergency evacuation training.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 34.0021, Education Code, is amended by 5 amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsection (c-1) to 6 read as follows:

7 (a) Pursuant to the safety standards established by the 8 Department of Public Safety under Section 34.002, each school 9 district <u>may</u> [shall] conduct a training session for students and 10 teachers concerning procedures for evacuating a school bus during 11 an emergency.

12 (b) A school district that chooses to conduct a training session under Subsection (a) is encouraged to [shall] conduct the 13 14 school bus emergency evacuation training session [at least twice each school year, with one training session occurring] in the fall 15 16 of the school year [and one training session occurring in the spring]. The school district is also encouraged to structure the 17 training session so that a [A] portion of the [training] session 18 occurs [must occur] on a school bus and the [training] session lasts 19 [must last] for at least one hour. 20

21 (c-1) Immediately before each field trip involving 22 transportation by school bus, a school district is encouraged to 23 review school bus emergency evacuation procedures with the school 24 bus passengers, including a demonstration of the school bus

1 emergency exits and the safe manner to exit.

2 SECTION 2. Sections 34.0021(d) and (e), Education Code, are 3 repealed.

4 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2009-2010 5 school year.

6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
