- 5 SECTION 1. Section 46.15, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subsection (g) to read as follows:
- 7 (g) The provisions of Sections 46.02 and 46.03 prohibiting
- 8 the possession or carrying of a club do not apply to an animal
- 9 control officer who holds a certificate issued under Section
- 10 829.006, Health and Safety Code, and who possesses or carries an
- 11 instrument used specifically for deterring the bite of an animal
- 12 while the officer is in the performance of official duties under the
- 13 Health and Safety Code or is traveling to or from a place of duty.
- SECTION 2. Section 829.003(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 (a) The department shall prescribe the standards and
- 17 curriculum for basic and continuing education animal control
- 18 courses. The curriculum for both the basic and continuing
- 19 education courses must include the following topics:
- 20 (1) state laws governing animal control and protection
- 21 and animal cruelty;
- 22 (2) animal health and disease recognition, control,
- 23 and prevention;
- 24 (3) the humane care and treatment of animals;

- 1 (4) standards for care and control of animals in an
- 2 animal shelter;
- 3 (5) standards and procedures for the transportation of
- 4 animals;
- 5 (6) principles and procedures for capturing and
- 6 handling stray domestic animals and wildlife, including principles
- 7 and procedures to be followed with respect to an instrument used
- 8 specifically for deterring the bite of an animal;
- 9 (7) first aid for injured animals;
- 10 (8) the documentation of animal cruelty evidence and
- 11 courtroom procedures;
- 12 (9) animal shelter operations and administration;
- 13 (10) spaying and neutering, microchipping, and
- 14 adoption;
- 15 (11) communications and public relations;
- 16 (12) state and federal laws for possession of
- 17 controlled substances and other medications; and
- 18 (13) any other topics pertinent to animal control and
- 19 animal shelter personnel.
- SECTION 3. Section 829.003(a), Health and Safety Code, as
- 21 amended by this Act, applies to the curriculum required for basic
- 22 and continuing education animal control courses offered under
- 23 Section 829.004, Health and Safety Code, on or after January 1,
- 24 2010.
- 25 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
