A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to a prohibition against changing the name of certain 3 public institutions of higher education that are named after state 4 historical figures.

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is 7 amended by adding Section 51.9051 to read as follows:

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

8 <u>Sec. 51.9051. PRESERVING INSTITUTION NAME BASED ON STATE</u> 9 <u>HISTORICAL FIGURE. (a) In this section, "general academic</u> 10 <u>teaching institution," "governing board," and "public state</u> 11 <u>college" have the meanings assigned by Section 61.003.</u>

12 (b) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall 13 maintain a registry that includes each general academic teaching 14 institution, other than a public state college, that is named after 15 an established historical figure of this state, as determined by 16 the coordinating board in consultation with the Texas Historical 17 <u>Commission.</u>

18 (c) The governing board of an institution included on the 19 registry may not change the name of the institution in a manner that 20 removes the name of the established historical figure from the name 21 of the institution.

22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
