## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to standing for certain individuals to file a suit

3 affecting the parent-child relationship.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 102.006(c), Family Code, is amended to

6 read as follows:

- 7 (c) The limitations on filing suit imposed by this section
- 8 do not apply to <u>a person related to the child by consanguinity as</u>
- 9 <u>determined under Section 573.022</u>, <u>Government Code</u>, [<del>an adult</del>
- 10 sibling of the child, a grandparent of the child, an aunt who is a
- 11 sister of a parent of the child, or an uncle who is a brother of a
- 12 parent of the child] if the person [adult sibling, grandparent,
- 13 aunt, or uncle] files an original suit or a suit for modification
- 14 requesting managing conservatorship or adoption of the child not
- 15 later than the 120th [90th] day after the date the parent-child
- 16 relationship between the child and the parent is terminated in a
- 17 suit filed by the Department of Family and Protective Services
- 18 requesting the termination of the parent-child relationship.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
