- 16 the minimum number of semester credit hours required to complete

1 (B) excluding: 2 (i) course credit that is earned to satisfy requirements for a Reserve Officers' Training Corps (ROTC) program 3 4 but that is not required to complete the degree program; and 5 (ii) course credit earned through 6 participation in an optional internship program sponsored or approved by an institution of higher education, if the student 7 earned the credit while enrolled at that institution. 8 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 9 to a student who is awarded a baccalaureate degree from a general 10 academic teaching institution on or after the effective date of 11 this Act. 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 14 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 16

Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
