A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to one-time supplemental payments of retirement or death
- 3 benefits by the Teacher Retirement System of Texas.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) The Teacher Retirement System of Texas
- 6 shall make a one-time supplemental payment of a retirement or death
- 7 benefit, as provided by this section.
- 8 (b) The supplemental payment is payable not later than
- 9 September 2009 and, to the extent practicable, on a date or dates
- 10 that coincide with the regular annuity payment payable to each
- 11 eligible annuitant.
- 12 (c) The amount of the supplemental payment is equal to the
- 13 lesser of:
- 14 (1) the gross amount of the regular annuity payment to
- which the eligible annuitant is otherwise entitled for the month of
- 16 August 2009; or
- 17 (2) \$2,400.
- 18 (d) The supplemental payment is payable without regard to
- 19 any forfeiture of benefits under Section 824.601, Government Code.
- 20 The Teacher Retirement System of Texas shall make applicable tax
- 21 withholding and other legally required deductions before
- 22 disbursing the supplemental payment. A supplemental payment under
- 23 this section is in addition to and not in lieu of the regular
- 24 monthly annuity payment to which the eligible annuitant is

- 1 otherwise entitled.
- 2 (e) Subject to Subsection (f) of this section, to be
- 3 eligible for the supplemental payment, a person must be, for the
- 4 month of August 2009, and disregarding any forfeiture of benefits
- 5 under Section 824.601, Government Code, an annuitant eligible to
- 6 receive:
- 7 (1) a standard retirement annuity payment;
- 8 (2) an optional retirement annuity payment as either a
- 9 retiree or beneficiary;
- 10 (3) a life annuity payment under Section
- 11 824.402(a)(4), Government Code;
- 12 (4) an annuity for a guaranteed period of 60 months
- under Section 824.402(a)(3), Government Code; or
- 14 (5) an alternate payee annuity payment under Section
- 15 804.005, Government Code.
- 16 (f) If the annuitant is a retiree or a beneficiary under an
- 17 optional retirement payment plan, to be eligible for the
- 18 supplemental payment, the effective date of the retirement of the
- 19 member of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas must have been on
- or before December 31, 2008. If the annuitant is a beneficiary
- under Section 824.402(a)(3) or (4), Government Code, to be eligible
- for the supplemental payment, the date of death of the member of the
- 23 retirement system must have been on or before December 31, 2008.
- 24 The supplemental payment shall be made to an alternate payee who is
- an annuitant under Section 804.005, Government Code, only if the
- 26 annuity payment to the alternate payee commenced on or before
- 27 December 31, 2008. The supplemental payment is in addition to the

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- 1 guaranteed number of payments under Section 824.402(a)(3),
- 2 Government Code, Section 824.204(c)(3) or (4), Government Code, or
- 3 Section 824.308(c)(3) or (4), Government Code, and may not be
- 4 counted as one of the guaranteed monthly payments.
- 5 (g) The supplemental payment does not apply to payments
- 6 under:
- 7 (1) Section 824.304(a), Government Code, relating to
- 8 disability retirees with less than 10 years of service credit;
- 9 (2) Section 824.804(b), Government Code, relating to
- 10 participants in the deferred retirement option plan with regard to
- 11 payments from their deferred retirement option plan accounts;
- 12 (3) Section 824.501(a), Government Code, relating to
- 13 retiree survivor beneficiaries who receive a survivor annuity in an
- 14 amount fixed by statute; or
- 15 (4) Section 824.404(a), Government Code, relating to
- 16 active member survivor beneficiaries who receive a survivor annuity
- in an amount fixed by statute.
- (h) Except as provided by this section, the board of
- 19 trustees of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas shall determine
- 20 the eligibility for and the amount and timing of a supplemental
- 21 payment and the manner in which the payment is made.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
