## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

Τ	AN ACT
2	relating to requiring certain service stations to be capable of
3	operating with alternate generated power.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle C, Title 5, Business & Commerce Code, is
6	amended by adding Chapter 106 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 106. ALTERNATE POWER REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTAIN SERVICE
8	<u>STATIONS</u>
9	Sec. 106.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
10	(1) "Alternate power generator" means a generator that
11	is capable of providing electric power when electric utility
12	service is interrupted.
13	(2) "Service station" has the meaning assigned by
14	<u>Section 105.001.</u>
15	Sec. 106.002. APPLICABILITY OF CHAPTER. (a) This chapter
16	applies only to a self-service, full-service, or combination of
17	<pre>self-service and full-service service station that:</pre>
18	(1) has six or more fueling positions; and
19	(2) is located in a county with a population of at
20	<pre>least three million.</pre>
21	(b) This chapter applies to a service station described by
22	Subsection (a) regardless of whether the service station is located
23	on the grounds of, or is owned by, another business entity that does

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not engage in the business of selling motor vehicle fuel to the

- 1 public.
- 2 <u>(c)</u> This chapter does not apply to:
- 3 (1) a person who operates a fleet of motor vehicles; or
- 4 (2) a person who sells motor vehicle fuel exclusively
- 5 to a fleet of motor vehicles.
- 6 Sec. 106.003. ALTERNATE GENERATED POWER CAPACITY FOR
- 7 SERVICE STATIONS. A service station shall be equipped with an
- 8 alternate power generator and be capable of operating all fuel
- 9 pumps, dispensing equipment, life-safety systems, and
- 10 payment-acceptance equipment using an alternate power generator
- 11 for a minimum of 72 hours.
- Sec. 106.004. REQUIRED DOCUMENTS. (a) A service station
- 13 must keep a copy of the documentation of the installation of
- 14 appropriate wiring for the operation of an alternate power
- 15 generator, including a transfer switch, on site or at its corporate
- 16 headquarters.
- 17 (b) A service station must keep a written statement
- 18 attesting to the periodic testing and ensured operational capacity
- 19 of the equipment.
- 20 (c) The documents required by this section must be made
- 21 available, on request, to the governor's division of emergency
- 22 <u>management or the Department of Agriculture.</u>
- 23 SECTION 2. A newly constructed service station that begins
- operating on or after the effective date of this Act shall comply
- with Chapter 106, Business & Commerce Code, as added by this Act,
- 26 beginning on the first day of operation. A service station that
- 27 begins operating before the effective date of this Act shall comply

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- 1 with Chapter 106, Business & Commerce Code, as added by this Act,
- 2 not later than January 1, 2011.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2009.
