## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to health benefit plan coverage for autism spectrum

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 1355.015(a) and (e), Insurance Code,
- 6 are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) At a minimum, a health benefit plan must provide
- 8 coverage as provided by this section to an enrollee at least [older
- 9 than] two years of age and younger than 18 [six] years of age who is
- 10 diagnosed with autism spectrum disorder. [If an enrollee who is
- 11 being treated for autism spectrum disorder becomes six years of age
- 12 or older and continues to need treatment, this subsection does not
- 13 preclude coverage of treatment and services described by Subsection
- 14 <del>(b).</del>]
- 15 (e) Notwithstanding any other law, this section applies
- 16 [does not apply] to a standard health benefit plan provided under
- 17 Chapter 1507.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a health benefit plan
- 19 delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1,
- 20 2010. A health benefit plan delivered, issued for delivery, or
- 21 renewed before January 1, 2010, is governed by the law as it existed
- 22 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
- 23 continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
