1-7 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to the designation of a segment of State Highway 158 in
1-10 Runnels County as the Army Specialist William Justin Byler Memorial
1-11 Highway.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
1-14 is amended by adding Section 225.078 to read as follows:

1-15 Sec. 225.078. ARMY SPECIALIST WILLIAM JUSTIN BYLER MEMORIAL
1-16 HIGHWAY. (a) State Highway 158 in Runnels County, between Farm
1-17 Road 2887 and Ranch Road 2111, is designated as the Army Specialist
1-18 William Justin Byler Memorial Highway.

1-19 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall
1-20 design and construct memorial markers indicating the highway
1-21 number, the designation as the Army Specialist William Justin Byler
1-22 Memorial Highway, and any other appropriate information. The
1-23 department shall erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
1-24 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
