A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT relating to an administrative fee for defendants required by a court to perform community service in lieu of serving a term of confinement in county jail. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. A defendant shall pay an administrative fee not to exceed \$50 under

19 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only 20 to a defendant convicted of an offense committed on or after the 21 effective date of this Act. A defendant convicted of an offense 22 committed before the effective date of this Act is covered by the 23 law in effect when the offense was committed, and the former law is 24 continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section,
