- 8 registrar, a person must be eligible to register to vote in the
- 9 county served by the registrar [18 years of age or older].
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 13.032, Election Code, is amended to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 13.032. PROHIBITION ON REFUSING TO APPOINT. A
- 13 registrar may not refuse to appoint as a volunteer deputy
- 14 registrar:
- 15 (1) a person eligible to register to vote in [resident
- 16 of the county served by the registrar; or
- 17 (2) any person on the basis of sex, race, creed, color,
- 18 or national origin or ancestry.
- 19 SECTION 3. The appointment of a person serving as a
- 20 volunteer deputy registrar who does not meet the eligibility
- 21 requirements of Section 13.031(d), Election Code, as amended by
- 22 this Act, expires on the effective date of this Act. The secretary
- 23 of state shall prescribe procedures necessary to implement this
- 24 section.
