## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the authority of a county or municipality to remove
3	graffiti from private property at the owner's expense.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 250, Local Government Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 250.007 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 250.007. GRAFFITI REMOVAL. (a) A county or
8	municipality may require an owner of property within the
9	jurisdiction of the county or municipality to remove graffiti from
10	the owner's property.
11	(b) A requirement adopted under this section shall provide
12	that if an owner of property fails to remove graffiti not later than
13	the seventh day after the date of notice, the county or municipality
14	may:
15	(1) perform the work necessary to remove the graffiti;
16	<u>or</u>
17	(2) pay for the removal of the graffiti and charge the
18	expense to the owner of the property.
19	(c) The notice required by Subsection (b) must be given:
20	(1) personally to the owner in writing;
21	(2) by letter sent by certified mail, addressed to the
22	owner at the owner's address as contained in the records of the
23	appraisal district in which the property is located; or
24	(3) if service cannot be obtained under Subdivision

- 1 (1) or (2):
- 2 (A) by publication at least once;
- 3 (B) by posting the notice on or near the front
- 4 door of each building on the property to which the notice relates;
- 5 or
- 6 (C) by posting the notice on a placard attached
- 7 to a stake driven into the ground on the property to which the
- 8 notice relates.
- 9 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 101, Civil Practice and
- 10 Remedies Code, is amended by adding Section 101.067 to read as
- 11 follows:
- 12 Sec. 101.067. GRAFFITI REMOVAL. This chapter does not
- 13 apply to a claim for property damage caused by the removal of
- 14 graffiti under Section 250.007, Local Government Code.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
