A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the registration of certain assisted living facilities;
3	providing penalties.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 247, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 247.033 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 247.033. REGISTRATION OF CERTAIN FACILITIES. (a) The
8	executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission
9	by rule shall require registration for a facility that:
10	(1) furnishes food and shelter to three or fewer
11	persons who are unrelated to the proprietor of the facility; and
12	(2) provides personal care services.
13	(b) A person may not operate a facility described by
14	Subsection (a) unless the person registers the facility with the
15	department according to this section and rules adopted under this
16	section.
17	(c) A person may apply for registration of a facility under
18	this section by submitting:
19	(1) an application for registration on a form
20	<pre>prescribed by the department; and</pre>
21	(2) a fee of \$200.
22	(d) A registration is valid until the second anniversary of
23	the date of issuance.

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(e) A facility registered under this section shall grant

- 1 reasonable access to the department and its designees:
- 2 (1) for inquiries and visits to a facility; and
- 3 (2) to permit reporting of instances of abuse,
- 4 <u>neglect</u>, or exploitation observed or reported during the visits.
- 5 (f) Notwithstanding Section 48.301, Human Resources Code,
- 6 or Section 247.043, the Department of Family and Protective
- 7 Services may conduct investigations of abuse, neglect, and
- 8 <u>exploitation at facilities registered under this section in</u>
- 9 accordance with Chapter 48, Human Resources Code.
- 10 (g) The department may deny, suspend, or revoke a
- 11 registration for a violation of this chapter or a rule adopted under
- 12 this chapter.
- (h) A person who operates a facility that is required to be
- 14 registered under this section without a current registration or who
- 15 violates this section or a rule adopted under this section is
- subject to the remedies and penalties provided by Subchapter C as if
- 17 the person held or is required to hold a license under this
- 18 subchapter.
- 19 SECTION 2. (a) Not later than January 1, 2010, the
- 20 executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission
- 21 shall adopt the rules necessary to implement Section 247.033,
- Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act.
- 23 (b) Notwithstanding Section 247.033, Health and Safety
- 24 Code, as added by this Act, a facility is not required to register
- with the Department of Aging and Disability Services before March
- 26 1, 2010.
- 27 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
