A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the expansion of the boundaries of the Dallas County

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 281, Health and Safety
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 281.058 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 281.058. EXPANSION OF DALLAS COUNTY HOSPITAL DISTRICT
- 8 TERRITORY. (a) Notwithstanding any other law, registered voters
- 9 of a defined territory composed of one or more counties contiguous
- 10 to Dallas County, Texas, that is not included in the boundaries of
- 11 the Dallas County Hospital District may file a petition with the
- 12 <u>Commissioners Court of Dallas County requesting inclusion in the</u>
- 13 <u>district</u>. The petition must be signed by at least 50 registered
- 14 voters of the defined territory or a majority of those voters,
- 15 whichever is less.
- 16 (b) Regardless of whether a petition is filed under
- 17 Subsection (a), the Commissioners Court of Dallas County may pursue
- 18 the issue of annexing territory to the district.
- 19 (c) The Commissioners Court of Dallas County shall set a
- 20 time and place to hold a hearing on the issue of annexing territory
- 21 to the district. The commissioners court shall set a date for the
- 22 hearing that is not earlier than the 31st day after the date the
- 23 court issues the order.
- 24 (d) If after the hearing the Commissioners Court of Dallas

- 1 County finds that annexation of territory into the district would
- 2 be feasible and would benefit the district, the commissioners court
- 3 may approve the annexation by a resolution entered in its minutes.
- 4 If the commissioners court is acting in response to a petition, the
- 5 commissioners court is not required to include all of the territory
- 6 described in the petition if a modification or change is found to be
- 7 necessary or desirable. The Commissioners Court of Dallas County
- 8 shall send a copy of the resolution to the commissioners court of
- 9 each county in which the territory to be annexed is included.
- 10 (e) Annexation of territory is final when approved by a
- 11 majority of the voters at an election held in the district and by a
- 12 majority of the voters at a separate election held in the territory
- 13 to be annexed. If the district has outstanding debts or taxes, the
- 14 voters in the election to approve the annexation must also
- 15 determine if the annexed territory will assume its proportion of
- 16 the debts or taxes if added to the district. A commissioners court
- 17 that receives a copy of a resolution under Subsection (d) shall
- 18 cooperate with the Commissioners Court of Dallas County in holding
- 19 the elections required by this subsection.
- 20 (f) The election ballots shall be printed to provide for
- 21 voting for or against the following, as applicable:
- 22 (1) "Adding (description of territory to be added) to
- 23 the Dallas County Hospital District."; or
- 24 (2) "(Description of territory to be added) assuming
- 25 its proportionate share of the outstanding debts and taxes of the
- 26 Dallas County Hospital District, if it is added to the district."

- 1 section is included in the boundaries of another hospital district,
- 2 the election to approve adding the territory to the district under
- 3 this section is to be treated for all purposes as an election to
- 4 dissolve the other hospital district in accordance with Section 9,
- 5 Article IX, Texas Constitution, and Sections 286.102 through
- 6 286.106.
- 7 (h) The ballot language at an election to which Subsection
- 8 (g) applies must clearly state that the final approval of the
- 9 annexation of the territory will result in the dissolution of the
- 10 other hospital district.
- 11 (i) Once annexation is approved, the Commissioners Court of
- 12 Dallas County shall appoint an advisory committee with
- 13 representatives from each county included in the annexed territory
- 14 to represent the interests of the county.
- 15 (j) This section does not affect the authority given to the
- 16 Commissioners Court of Dallas County under this chapter.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect on the date on which the
- 18 constitutional amendment proposed by the 81st Legislature, Regular
- 19 Session, 2009, to allow the Dallas County Hospital District to
- 20 expand its boundaries takes effect. If that amendment is not
- 21 approved by the voters, this Act has no effect.
