- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 501, Business & Commerce
- 6 Code, as effective April 1, 2009, is amended by adding Section
- 7 501.1011 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 501.1011. SALES RECEIPT CONTAINING DRIVER'S LICENSE
- 9 NUMBER PROHIBITED. A person may not print an individual's driver's
- 10 <u>license number on a receipt or other document that evidences</u>
- 11 payment for a sale of goods or services and is provided to the
- 12 <u>individual.</u>
- SECTION 2. Section 501.102, Business & Commerce Code, as
- 14 effective April 1, 2009, is amended by amending Subsection (a) and
- 15 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 16 (a) A person who violates Section 501.101 [this subchapter]
- 17 is liable to this state for a civil penalty in an amount not to
- 18 exceed \$500 for each violation. The attorney general or the
- 19 prosecuting attorney in the county in which the violation occurs
- 20 may bring an action to recover the civil penalty imposed under this
- 21 subsection [section].
- 22 <u>(a-1) A person who violates Section 501.1011 is liable to</u>
- 23 this state for a civil penalty in an amount not to exceed \$500 for
- 24 each calendar month in which a violation occurs. The civil penalty

- 1 may not be imposed for more than one violation that occurs in a
- 2 month. The attorney general or the prosecuting attorney in the
- 3 county in which the violation occurs may bring an action to recover
- 4 the civil penalty imposed under this subsection.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2010.
