8	TRAFFICKING OF PERSONS. (a) The commission by rule shall require an
9	officer first licensed by the commission on or after January 1,
10	2011, to complete within a reasonable time after obtaining the
11	license a one-time basic education and training program on the
12	trafficking of persons. The program must:
13	(1) consist of at least four hours of training; and
14	(2) include a review of the substance of Sections
15	20A.02 and 43.05, Penal Code.
16	(b) The commission shall make available to each officer a
17	voluntary advanced education, instruction, and training program on
18	the trafficking of persons, sex trafficking, and compelling
19	prostitution prohibited under Sections 20A.02 and 43.05, Penal
20	<u>Code.</u>
21	(c) Not later than January 1, 2011, the commission shall
22	begin offering the basic and advanced programs established under
23	this section. This subsection expires September 1, 2011.
24	SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2010, the Commission
