AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Sections 545.412(e) and (f), Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows:

This section does not apply to a person:
(1) operating a vehicle transporting passengers for excluding [<del>including</del>] third-party transport service providers when transporting clients pursuant to a contract to provide nonemergency Medicaid transportation; or

transporting a child in a vehicle in which all (2) seating positions equipped with child passenger safety seat systems

or safety belts are occupied.

In this section:

- "Child passenger safety seat system" means an (1)infant or child passenger restraint system that meets the federal standards for crash-tested restraint systems as set by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.
- "Passenger vehicle" means a passenger car, light (2) truck, sport utility vehicle, <u>passenger van designed to transport</u> 15 or fewer passengers, including the driver, truck, or truck tractor.
- "Safety belt" means a lap belt and any shoulder straps included as original equipment on or added to a vehicle.
- "Secured," in connection with use of a safety (4)belt, means using the lap belt and any shoulder straps according to the instructions of:
- (A) the manufacturer of the vehicle, if safety belt is original equipment; or
- the manufacturer of the safety belt, if the (B) safety belt has been added to the vehicle.

SECTION 2. Section 545.413, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:

A person commits an offense if the person allows a (b-1)child who is younger than 17 years of age and who is not required to be secured in a child passenger safety seat system under Section 545.412(a) to ride in a passenger van designed to transport 15 or fewer passengers, including the driver, without securing the child individually by a safety belt, if the child is occupying a seat that

is equipped with a safety belt.
SECTION 3. Section 545.416, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Subsections (d) and (e) to read as follows:

(d) Except as provided by Subsection (e), an operator may not carry another person on a motorcycle unless the other person is at least five years of age. An offense under this subsection is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than \$100 or more than \$200. It is a defense to prosecution under this subsection that the operator was operating the motorcycle in an emergency or for a law enforcement purpose.

(e) Subsection (d) does not prohibit an operator from carrying on a motorcycle a person younger than five years of age who is seated in a sidecar attached to the motorcycle.
