2	relating to disclosure at a facility performing certain laser
3	cosmetic procedures.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle G, Title 2, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Chapter 147 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 147. NONABLATIVE LASER AND PULSED LIGHT PROCEDURES
8	Sec. 147.001. SIGNED STATEMENT REQUIRED. Before a person
9	may perform a nonablative laser or pulsed light cosmetic procedure,
LO	the person must require that each person for whom the procedure is
L1	to be performed sign a written statement:
L2	(1) detailing the qualifications of the person
L3	performing the procedure;
L4	(2) describing the availability of a physician,
L5	advanced practice nurse, or other person with medical training who
L6	is associated with the facility where the procedure is performed;
L7	(3) stating whether the medical professional
L8	described by Subdivision (2) is at the facility or on call;
L9	(4) providing contact information for the medical
20	professional described by Subdivision (2); and
21	(5) detailing the risks associated with the procedure.
22	Sec. 147.002. SIGN REQUIRED. (a) A person performing a
23	nonablative laser or pulsed light cosmetic procedure shall display
24	a sign that discloses to prospective recipients of the procedure

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- 1 whether a physician, in case of emergency or any complication:
- 2 (1) is employed at the facility where the procedure is
- 3 performed;
- 4 (2) has delegating powers to the facility; or
- 5 (3) is located within reasonable proximity to the
- 6 facility.
- 7 (b) The sign required by Subsection (a) must display the
- 8 contact information for the physician.
- 9 SECTION 2. The executive commissioner of the Health and
- 10 Human Services Commission shall adopt rules necessary to administer
- 11 Chapter 147, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
