## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the electronic distribution of information to
- 3 legislators by state agencies.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 2052.002(a) and (c), Government Code,
- 6 are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) To avoid waste in the duplication and distribution of
- 8 state agency publications, a state agency that issues a publication
- 9 relating to the work of the agency and distributes the publication
- 10 to members of the legislature shall send to each member before
- 11 distributing the publication an electronic [a written] notice to
- 12 determine whether the member wants to receive the publication.
- 13 (c) A member who elects to receive the publication shall
- 14 notify the state agency. The member may notify the agency
- 15 electronically.
- SECTION 2. Section 2052.0021(d), Government Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 (d) At the time a report required by law is ready for
- 19 distribution outside the state agency, the agency shall send
- 20 written notice to each member of the legislature that the report is
- 21 available. The agency shall send the notice [by mail or, if it is
- 22 acceptable to the member, electronically. The notice must briefly
- 23 describe the subject matter of the report and state:
- 24 (1) the manner in which the member may obtain the

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- 1 report electronically; and
- 2 (2) that the agency will send a printed copy of the
- 3 report to the member at the request of the member.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
