- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 665B, Texas Probate Code, is amended to
- read as follows: 6
- Sec. 665B. PAYMENT OF ATTORNEY'S FEES TO [COMPENSATION OF] 7
- CERTAIN ATTORNEYS. (a) A court that creates a guardianship for a 8
- 9 ward under this chapter, on request of a person who filed an
- application to be appointed guardian of the proposed ward or for the 10
- appointment of another suitable person as guardian of the proposed 11
- 12 ward, may authorize the payment of reasonable and necessary
- attorney's fees, as determined by the court, to [compensation of] 13
- 14 an attorney who represents the person who filed the application at
- the application hearing, regardless of whether the person is 15
- appointed the ward's quardian, from: 16
- (1)available funds of the ward's estate; or 17
- 18 subject to Subsection (c) of this section, the
- county treasury if: 19
- 20 the ward's estate is insufficient to pay for
- 21 the services provided by the attorney; and
- 22 (B) funds in the county treasury are budgeted for

- 1 [compensation] under this section unless the court finds that the
- 2 applicant acted in good faith and for just cause in the filing and
- 3 prosecution of the application.
- 4 (c) The court may authorize the payment of attorney's fees
- 5 from the county treasury under Subsection (a) of this section only
- 6 if the court is satisfied that the attorney to whom the fees will be
- 7 paid has not received, and is not seeking, payment for the services
- 8 described by that subsection from any other source.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 665B, Texas Probate Code, as amended by
- 10 this Act, applies only to the payment of attorney's fees with
- 11 respect to an application for the appointment of a guardian that is
- 12 filed on or after the effective date of this Act. The payment of
- 13 attorney's fees with respect to an application for the appointment
- 14 of a quardian filed before the effective date of this Act is
- 15 governed by the law in effect on the date the application was filed,
- 16 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
