A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to an intercollegiate athletics fee at Midwestern State
3	University.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 54, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 54.5442 to read as follows:

- 7 Sec. 54.5442. INTERCOLLEGIATE ATHLETICS FEE; MIDWESTERN
- 8 STATE UNIVERSITY. (a) The board of regents of Midwestern State
- 9 University may charge each student enrolled at the university an
- 10 intercollegiate athletics fee in an amount not to exceed:
- 11 (1) the lesser of \$10 per semester credit hour or \$120
- 12 for each regular semester or each summer session of more than six
- 13 weeks; or
- 14 (2) \$60 for each summer session of six weeks or less.
- (b) The fee may be used only to develop and maintain an
- 16 intercollegiate athletics program at the university.
- 17 <u>(c)</u> The amount of the fee may not be increased by more than
- 18 10 percent from one academic year to the next unless the increase
- 19 has been approved by a majority vote of the students enrolled at the
- 20 university who participate in a general student election called for
- 21 that purpose.
- 22 (d) The chief fiscal officer of the university shall collect
- 23 the fee and shall deposit the revenue from the fee in an account to
- 24 be known as the Midwestern State University intercollegiate

- 1 athletics fee account.
- 2 <u>(e)</u> The fee is not considered in determining the maximum
- 3 amount of student services fees that may be charged under Section
- 4 54.503.
- 5 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 6 to fees imposed for a semester or term that begins on or after the
- 7 effective date of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
