- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 455, Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 455.2021 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 455.2021. MASSAGE ESTABLISHMENT HOURS OF OPERATION.
- 8 (a) This section applies only to massage establishments located in
- 9 a county with a population of 3.3 million or more.
- 10 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), a massage
- 11 establishment may provide services only between the hours of 7 a.m.
- 12 and 10 p.m.
- (c) On application by a massage establishment, the
- 14 commissioners court of the county in which the massage
- 15 establishment is located may exempt the massage establishment from
- 16 the requirement of Subsection (b).
- 17 (d) The entrance doors to a massage establishment may not be
- 18 equipped with an electronic locking device that can be temporarily
- 19 <u>disengaged from a remote location.</u>
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
