- 2 relating to the purchase of plug-in hybrid electric vehicles by

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 2158, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 2158.010 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 2158.010. PURCHASE OF PLUG-IN HYBRID ELECTRIC
- 8 VEHICLES. (a) In this section, "plug-in hybrid electric vehicle"
- 9 means a vehicle that is powered by both:
- 10 (1) <u>an internal combustion engine; and</u>
- 11 (2) an electric motor supplied by batteries that can
- 12 be charged from an external electrical outlet.
- 13 (b) Notwithstanding Section 2158.004, 2158.005, or 2158.009
- 14 or any other law, a state agency may not purchase a vehicle unless
- 15 the vehicle is a plug-in hybrid electric vehicle.
- (c) Subsection (b) does not apply if the state agency
- 17 determines that the cost over a five-year period to purchase and
- 18 operate a plug-in hybrid electric vehicle of the type required by
- 19 the agency is greater than the cost over a five-year period to
- 20 purchase and operate a similar vehicle that is not a plug-in hybrid
- 21 <u>electric vehicle.</u>
- 22 SECTION 2. The heading to Subchapter A, Chapter 2158,
- 23 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
