## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT 1 2 relating to the purchase of plug-in hybrid electric vehicles by 3 state agencies. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 2158, Government Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 2158.010 to read as follows: Sec. 2158.010. PURCHASE OF PLUG-IN HYBRID ELECTRIC 7 VEHICLES. (a) In this section, "plug-in hybrid electric vehicle" 8 9 means a vehicle that is powered by both: (1) an internal combustion engine; and 10 11 (2) an electric motor supplied by batteries that can 12 be charged from an external electrical outlet. (b) Notwithstanding Section 2158.004, 2158.005, or 2158.009 13 14 or any other law, a state agency may not purchase a vehicle unless the vehicle is a plug-in hybrid electric vehicle. 15 (c) Subsection (b) does not apply if the state agency 16 determines that the cost over a five-year period to purchase and 17 18 operate a plug-in hybrid electric vehicle of the type required by the agency is greater than the cost over a five-year period to 19 purchase and operate a similar vehicle that is not a plug-in hybrid 20 21 electric vehicle. SECTION 2. The heading to Subchapter A, Chapter 2158, 22 23 Government Code, is amended to read as follows: SUBCHAPTER A. PURCHASE OF [PASSENCER] VEHICLES 24
