## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the regulation of retail electric providers.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 39.352, Utilities Code, is amended by
5	adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:
6	(c-1) Subject to Subsection (d), a retail electric provider
7	shall at all times maintain compliance with the requirements for
8	certification prescribed by Subsection (b) and with all other
9	applicable requirements prescribed by this title or by a commission
10	order or rule, including customer protection requirements,
11	disclosure requirements, and marketing guidelines. At least
12	annually and at any other time the commission may require, a retail
13	electric provider shall submit a report to the commission
14	concerning the financial viability of the retail electric provider.
15	At any time, the commission, on its own motion or on complaint, may:
16	(1) investigate the financial, managerial, and
17	technical performance of a retail electric provider; and
18	(2) inspect the books and records of a retail electric
19	provider.
20	SECTION 2. Section 39.352(e), Utilities Code, is repealed.
21	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
