A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the selection of certain members of the board of
- 3 trustees of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 821.001(5), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (5) "Board of trustees" means the board appointed $\underline{\text{or}}$
- 8 elected under this subtitle to administer the retirement system.
- 9 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 825.002, Government Code,
- 10 is amended to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 825.002. APPOINTMENT AND ELECTION OF TRUSTEES
- 12 [APPOINTED BY GOVERNOR].
- 13 SECTION 3. Sections 825.002(a), (c), (d), and (e),
- 14 Government Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 15 (a) The governor shall appoint, with the advice and consent
- of the senate and as provided by this section, three [seven] members
- of the board of trustees.
- 18 (c) Members of the retirement system whose most recent
- 19 credited service was performed for a public school district [The
- 20 governor] shall elect under rules adopted by the board [appoint]
- 21 two members of the board who must be [from a slate of three] members
- 22 of the retirement system <u>and</u> [who are] currently employed by a
- 23 public school district [and who have been nominated in accordance
- 24 with Subsection (f) by the members of the retirement system whose

- 3 (d) Persons who have retired and are receiving benefits from
- 4 the retirement system [The governor] shall elect under rules
- 5 adopted by the board [appoint] one member of the board who must be a
- 6 [from a slate of three] former member [members] of the retirement
- 7 system who is [have] retired and [are] receiving benefits from the
- 8 retirement system [and who have been nominated in accordance with
- 9 Subsections (f) and (g) by the persons who have retired and are
- 10 receiving benefits from the retirement system].
- 11 (e) Members of the retirement system whose most recent
- 12 credited service was performed for an institution of higher
- 13 <u>education</u> [The governor] shall <u>elect under rules adopted by the</u>
- 14 board [appoint] one member who must be a member [from a slate of
- 15 three members] of the retirement system and [who are] currently
- 16 employed by an institution of higher education [and who have been
- 17 nominated in accordance with Subsection (f) by the members of the
- 18 retirement system whose most recent credited service was performed
- 19 for an institution of higher education].
- SECTION 4. Sections 825.0032(a) and (b), Government Code,
- 21 are amended to read as follows:
- 22 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a person is not
- 23 eligible for appointment or election to the board if the person or
- the person's spouse:
- 25 (1) is employed by or participates in the management
- of a business entity or other organization receiving funds from the
- 27 retirement system;

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- 1 (2) owns or controls, directly or indirectly, more
- 2 than a 10 percent interest in a business entity or other
- 3 organization receiving funds from the retirement system; or
- 4 (3) uses or receives a substantial amount of tangible
- 5 goods, services, or funds from the retirement system, other than
- 6 compensation or reimbursement authorized by law for board
- 7 membership, attendance, or expenses.
- 8 (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to employment by,
- 9 participation in the management of, or ownership or control of an
- 10 interest in a business entity or other organization on behalf of the
- 11 retirement system. Subsection (a)(3) does not apply to a person who
- is elected [nominated for appointment] under Section 825.002(c),
- 13 (d), or (e).
- SECTION 5. Sections 825.0041(a) and (c), Government Code,
- 15 are amended to read as follows:
- 16 (a) A person who is appointed or elected to and qualifies
- 17 for office as a member of the board of trustees may not vote,
- deliberate, or be counted as a member in attendance at a meeting of
- 19 the board until the person completes a training program that
- 20 complies with this section.
- 21 (c) A person appointed <u>or elected</u> to the board of trustees
- is entitled to reimbursement under Section 825.007 for the travel
- 23 expenses incurred in attending the training program regardless of
- 24 whether the attendance at the program occurs before or after
- 25 the person qualifies for office.
- SECTION 6. Section 825.009(a), Government Code, is amended
- 27 to read as follows:

- 1 (a) A trustee <u>elected</u> [appointed from a slate of members
 2 nominated by members of the retirement system] under Section
 3 825.002 is entitled to leave with pay from the trustee's public
 4 school employer to attend to the official business of the
 5 retirement system.
- 6 SECTION 7. Sections 825.010(a) and (c), Government Code, 7 are amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) It is a ground for removal from the board that a trustee:
- 9 (1) does not have at the time of taking office the qualifications required for the trustee's position;
- 11 (2) does not maintain during service on the board the 12 qualifications required for the trustee's position;
- 13 (3) violates a prohibition established by Section 14 825.002(b) or 825.0032;
- (4) cannot because of illness or disability discharge the trustee's duties for a substantial part of the term for which the trustee is appointed or elected; or
- 18 (5) is absent from more than half of the regularly
 19 scheduled board meetings that the person is eligible to attend
 20 during a calendar year without an excuse approved by a majority vote
 21 of the board.
- 22 (c) If the executive director has knowledge that a potential 23 ground for removal exists, the executive director shall notify the 24 presiding officer of the board of the ground. The presiding officer 25 shall then notify the appropriate appointing officer, if any, and 26 the attorney general that a potential ground for removal exists. If 27 the potential ground for removal involves the presiding officer,

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- 1 the executive director shall notify the next highest officer of the
- 2 board, who shall notify the appropriate appointing officer, if any,
- 3 and the attorney general that a potential ground for removal
- 4 exists.
- 5 SECTION 8. Sections 825.002(f) and (g), Government Code,
- 6 are repealed.
- 7 SECTION 9. (a) Section 825.002, Government Code, as amended
- 8 by this Act, applies only to the appointment or election of a member
- 9 of the board of trustees of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas
- 10 that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 11 (b) The change in the manner of appointing or electing
- 12 members of the board does not affect the appointment of members
- 13 serving on the board before the effective date of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 15 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 16 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 17 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- 18 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
