A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the salary paid to certain professional employees of 3 public schools.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Section 21.402, Education Code, is amended by amending Subsections (c) and (d) and adding Subsections (c-1) and (c-2) to read as follows:
- 8 (c) The salary factors per step are as follows:

- 19 (c-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), for the 2009-2010
- 20 school year, a classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time
- 21 counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school nurse
- is entitled to a monthly salary that is at least equal to the sum of:
- 23 (1) the monthly salary the employee would have
- 24 received for the 2009-2010 school year under the district's salary

- schedule for the 2008-2009 school year, if that schedule had been in
- 2 effect for the 2009-2010 school year, including any local
- 3 supplement and any money representing a career ladder supplement
- 4 the employee would have received in the 2009-2010 school year; and
- 5 (2) \$500.
- 6 (c-2) Subsection (c-1) and this subsection expire September
- 7 1, 2010.
- 8 (d) A classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time
- 9 counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school nurse
- 10 employed by a school district in the 2009-2010 [2006-2007] school
- 11 year is, as long as the employee is employed by the same district,
- 12 entitled to a salary that is at least equal to the salary the
- employee received for the 2009-2010 [$\frac{2006-2007}{2006}$] school year.
- SECTION 2. Section 42.2516, Education Code, is amended by
- 15 adding Subsection (e-1) to read as follows:
- 16 (e-1) The amount of state aid or credit to which a school
- district is entitled under Section 42.2518 is in addition to the
- 18 amount of revenue to which the district is entitled under
- 19 Subsection (b).
- SECTION 3. Subchapter E, Chapter 42, Education Code, is
- 21 amended by adding Section 42.2518 to read as follows:
- 22 <u>Sec. 42.2518. ADDITIONAL STATE AID OR CREDIT AGAINST COST</u>
- 23 OF ATTENDANCE CREDITS FOR PROFESSIONAL STAFF SALARIES. (a) A
- 24 school district, including a school district that is otherwise
- 25 ineligible for state aid under this chapter, is entitled to state
- 26 aid in an amount, as determined by the commissioner, equal to the
- 27 product of \$5,000 multiplied by the number of classroom teachers,

- 1 <u>full-time</u> librarians, full-time counselors certified under
- 2 Subchapter B, Chapter 21, and full-time school nurses employed by
- 3 the district and entitled to a minimum salary under Section 21.402.
- 4 (b) A school district that is required to take action under
- 5 Chapter 41 to reduce its wealth per student to the equalized wealth
- 6 level is entitled to a credit, in the amount of state aid to which
- 7 the district is entitled under this section, against the total
- 8 amount required under Section 41.093 for the district to purchase
- 9 attendance credits.
- 10 (c) A determination by the commissioner under this section
- is final and may not be appealed.
- 12 (d) The commissioner may adopt rules to implement this
- 13 section.
- SECTION 4. This Act applies beginning with the 2009-2010
- 15 school year.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
