3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 662.106 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 662.106. JUNETEENTH/FRONTIER COWBOY MONTH. (a) June
7	is Juneteenth/Frontier Cowboy Month to:
8	(1) honor the fortitude and achievements of Texas
9	cowboys of every ethnic background whose labors contributed
10	immeasurably to the development of this state; and
11	(2) recognize Texas cowboys of every ethnic background
12	as Texas heroes.
13	(b) Juneteenth/Frontier Cowboy Month shall be regularly
14	observed by appropriate celebrations and activities.
15	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
16	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
17	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
18	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
19	Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
