4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 313.051(a), Tax Code, is amended to read
6	as follows:
7	(a) This subchapter applies only to a school district that
8	has territory in:
9	(1) an area that qualified as a strategic investment
10	area under Subchapter O, Chapter 171, immediately before that
11	subchapter expired [, as defined by Section 171.721]; or
12	(2) a county:
13	(A) that has a population of less than 50,000;
14	<u>and</u>
15	(B) [that is not partially or wholly located in a
16	metropolitan statistical area; and
17	$[\frac{(C)}{C}]$ in which, from 1990 to 2000, according to
18	the federal decennial census, the population:
19	(i) remained the same;
20	(ii) decreased; or
21	(iii) increased, but at a rate of not more
22	than three percent per annum.
23	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
