A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to student members of the board of regents of a state 3 university system or a state university.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 51.355, Education Code, 6 is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 51.355. [NONVOTING] STUDENT REGENT; UNIVERSITY SYSTEM
8 BOARD OF REGENTS.

9 SECTION 2. Section 51.355, Education Code, is amended by 10 amending Subsections (c), (d-1), (e), and (i) and adding 11 Subsections (e-1), (e-2), and (j) to read as follows:

12 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (f), not later than 13 November 1 of each year, the student government of each general 14 academic teaching institution and medical and dental unit in a university system shall solicit applicants for appointment to the 15 next regular term of the position of student regent. Not later 16 than December [January] 1, from among the applications received by 17 the student government, the student government shall select five 18 applicants as the student government's recommendations for the 19 position of student regent and send the applications of those 20 21 applicants to the chancellor of the university system. From among 22 those applicants, the chancellor shall select two or more 23 applicants as the university system's recommendations for the position of student regent and shall send the applications of those 24

1 applicants to the governor not later than <u>January</u> [February] The governor may request to review all applications for the 2 1. 3 position of student regent received by the student governments and may request an applicant to submit additional information to the 4 5 Not later than February 1 [On June 1, or as soon governor. thereafter as practicable], the governor with the advice and 6 consent of the senate shall appoint one of the applicants to serve 7 as the student regent for the system for a one-year term expiring on 8 the next February 1 [May 31]. The governor is not required to 9 10 appoint an applicant recommended by the chancellor.

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11 (d-1) Throughout a student regent's term, the student 12 regent must maintain a grade point average of at least <u>3.0</u> [2.5] on 13 a four-point scale. The president of the institution in which the 14 student regent is enrolled shall notify the governor if the student 15 regent fails to maintain the qualifications required by this 16 section.

17 (e) <u>A student regent has the same powers and duties,</u> 18 <u>including voting privileges, as the other members of the board of</u> 19 <u>regents on which the student regent serves.</u>

(e-1) This subsection applies only to a student regent 20 appointed for a term expiring on or before February 1, 2011. 21 Subsection (e) does not apply to a student regent to whom this 22 23 subsection applies. A student regent is not a member of the board 24 of regents of the system for which the student regent is appointed. A student regent has the same powers and duties as the members of 25 26 the board of regents of the system, including the right to attend 27 and participate in meetings of the board of regents, except that the

1 student regent:

2 (1) may not vote on any matter before the board or make
3 or second any motion before the board; and

4 (2) is not counted in determining whether a quorum 5 exists for a meeting of the board or in determining the outcome of 6 any vote of the board.

7 (e-2) Subsection (e-1) and this subsection expire September
8 1, 2012.

9 (i) A student regent serves without compensation but is 10 entitled to be reimbursed for the actual expenses incurred by the 11 student regent in attending the meetings of the board of regents, 12 subject to the approval of the chairman of the board of regents. 13 <u>This subsection applies only to a student regent appointed for a</u> 14 <u>term expiring on or before February 1, 2011. This subsection</u> 15 <u>expires September 1, 2012.</u>

16 (j) If the one-year term of a student regent is held by a 17 final judgment of a court to violate Section 30a, Article XVI, Texas 18 Constitution, the student regent holds office for a term of six 19 years that expires in the same year in which the terms of two of the 20 other members of the board of regents expire. This subsection 21 applies only to the term of a student regent expiring on or after 22 February 1, 2012.

23 SECTION 3. The heading to Section 51.356, Education Code, 24 is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 51.356. [NONVOTING] STUDENT REGENT; INSTITUTION BOARD
 OF REGENTS.

27 SECTION 4. Section 51.356, Education Code, is amended by

3 (d) Not later than November 1 of each year, the student government of the general academic teaching institution shall 4 5 solicit applicants for appointment to the next regular term of the position of student regent. Not later than <u>December</u> [January] 1, 6 from among the applications received by the student government, the 7 8 student government shall select five applicants as the student government's recommendations for the position of student regent and 9 10 send the applications of those applicants to the president of the institution. From among those applicants, the president shall 11 select two or more applicants as the institution's recommendations 12 for the position of student regent and shall send the applications 13 14 of those applicants to the governor not later than January 15 [February] 1. The governor may request to review all applications for the position of student regent received by the student 16 17 government and may request an applicant to submit additional information to the governor. Not later than February 1 [On June 1, 18 19 or as soon thereafter as practicable], the governor with the advice and consent of the senate shall appoint one of the applicants to 20 serve as the student regent for the institution for a one-year term 21 expiring on the next February 1 [May 31]. The governor is not 22 23 required to appoint an applicant recommended by the president.

(e-1) Throughout a student regent's term, the student regent must maintain a grade point average of at least <u>3.0</u> [2.5] on a four-point scale. The president of the institution in which the student regent is enrolled shall notify the governor if the student

regent fails to maintain the qualifications required by this
 section.

3 (f) <u>A student regent has the same powers and duties</u>, 4 <u>including voting privileges</u>, as the other members of the board of 5 <u>regents on which the student regent serves</u>.

6 (f-1) This subsection applies only to a student regent 7 appointed for a term expiring on or before February 1, 2011. Subsection (f) does not apply to a student regent to whom this 8 subsection applies. A student regent is not a member of the board 9 of regents of the institution for which the student regent is 10 appointed. A student regent has the same powers and duties as the 11 members of the board of regents of the institution, including the 12 right to attend and participate in meetings of the board of regents, 13 14 except that the student regent:

15 (1) may not vote on any matter before the board or make16 or second any motion before the board; and

17 (2) is not counted in determining whether a quorum
18 exists for a meeting of the board or in determining the outcome of
19 any vote of the board.

20 (f-2) Subsection (f-1) and this subsection expire September
21 1, 2012.

(i) A student regent serves without compensation but is
entitled to be reimbursed for the actual expenses incurred by the
student regent in attending the meetings of the board of regents,
subject to the approval of the chairman of the board of regents.
<u>This subsection applies only to a student regent appointed for a</u>
<u>term expiring on or before February 1, 2011. This subsection</u>

1 expires September 1, 2012.

(j) If the one-year term of the student regent is held by a final judgment of a court to violate Section 30a, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, the student regent holds office for a term of six years that expires in the same year in which the terms of two of the other members of the board of regents expire. This subsection applies only to the term of a student regent expiring on or after <u>February 1, 2012.</u>

9 SECTION 5. Sections 65.11 and 65.12, Education Code, are 10 amended to read as follows:

11 Sec. 65.11. BOARD OF REGENTS. <u>(a)</u> The government of the 12 university system is vested in a board of nine regents appointed by 13 the governor with the advice and consent of the senate.

14 (b) One of the board members must be a student regent 15 serving under Section 51.355.

16 The board may provide for the administration, (c) 17 organization, and names of the institutions and entities in The University of Texas System in such a way as will achieve the maximum 18 19 operating efficiency of such institutions and entities, provided, however, that no institution or entity of The University of Texas 20 System not authorized by specific legislative act to offer a 21 four-year undergraduate program as of the effective date of this 22 23 Act shall offer any such four-year undergraduate program without 24 prior recommendation and approval by a two-thirds vote of the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board and a specific act of the 25 26 legislature [Legislature].

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Sec. 65.12. QUALIFICATIONS; TERMS. (a) Each member of

(a) Each member of the 18 board shall be a qualified voter. 19 (b) The board[; and the] members other than the student 20 regent shall be selected from different portions of the state. 21 The board members other than the student regent hold 22 (c) office for staggered terms of six years, with the terms of two or 23 three regents, as applicable, expiring February 1 of odd-numbered 24 25 years. 26 (d) The student regent holds office for a term of one year expiring February 1, with the term of the initial student regent 27

1 expiring February 1, 2012.

2 SECTION 7. Subchapter A, Chapter 95, Education Code, is 3 amended by amending Section 95.02 and adding Section 95.022 to read 4 as follows:

5 Sec. 95.02. BOARD <u>OF REGENTS</u> [MEMBERS: APPOINTMENT, 6 <u>QUALIFICATIONS, TERMS</u>]. <u>(a)</u> The board is composed of nine 7 members appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the 8 senate.

9 (b) One of the board members must be a student regent 10 serving under Section 51.355 [The members hold office for terms of 11 six years, with the terms of three members expiring February 1 of 12 odd-numbered years. Each member of the board shall be a qualified 13 voter; and the members shall be selected from different portions of 14 the state].

15 <u>Sec. 95.022. QUALIFICATIONS; TERMS. (a) Each member of the</u> 16 <u>board of regents other than the student regent must be a qualified</u> 17 <u>voter.</u>

(b) The board members other than the student regent shall be
 selected from different portions of the state.

20 (c) The board members other than the student regent hold 21 office for terms of six years, with the terms of two or three 22 regents, as applicable, expiring February 1 of odd-numbered years. 23 (d) The student regent holds office for a term of one year

24 <u>expiring February 1, with the term of the initial student regent</u> 25 expiring February 1, 2012.

26 SECTION 8. Sections 101.11 and 101.12, Education Code, are 27 amended to read as follows:

1 Sec. 101.11. BOARD OF REGENTS. (a) The control and 2 management of the university <u>are</u> [is] vested in a board of nine 3 regents appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the 4 senate.

5 (b) One of the board members must be a student regent 6 serving under Section 51.356.

Sec. 101.12. TERM OF OFFICE. (a) Members of the board
<u>other than the student regent</u> hold office for staggered terms of six
years, with the terms of <u>two or</u> three members, <u>as applicable</u>,
expiring [on] January 31 of each odd-numbered year.

11 (b) The student regent holds office for a term of one year 12 expiring February 1, with the term of the initial student regent 13 expiring February 1, 2012.

14 (c) Any vacancy shall be filled by appointment for the 15 unexpired portion of the term.

SECTION 9. Sections 103.02 and 103.03, Education Code, are amended to read as follows:

Sec. 103.02. BOARD OF REGENTS. (a) The organization, control, and management of the university <u>are</u> [is] vested in a board of nine regents.

(b) One of the board members must be a student regent
 serving under Section 51.356.

23 Sec. 103.03. BOARD MEMBERS: APPOINTMENT, TERMS, OATH. <u>(a)</u> 24 Members of the board shall be appointed by the governor and 25 confirmed by the senate.

(b) Members of the board other than the student regent hold
office for staggered terms of six years.

(c) The student regent holds office for a term of one year
 expiring February 1, with the term of the initial student regent
 expiring February 1, 2012.

4 (d) Any vacancy that occurs on the board shall be filled for 5 the unexpired term by appointment of the governor.

6 (e) Each member of the board shall take the constitutional 7 oath of office.

8 SECTION 10. Sections 105.051 and 105.052, Education Code, 9 are amended to read as follows:

10 Sec. 105.051. BOARD OF REGENTS. <u>(a)</u> The organization, 11 control, and management of the University of North Texas System and 12 each component institution of the system <u>are</u> [is] vested in a board 13 of nine regents appointed by the governor and confirmed by the 14 senate.

15 (b) One of the board members must be a student regent 16 serving under Section 51.355.

Sec. 105.052. TERM OF OFFICE; REMOVAL; VACANCY. (a) The term of office of each regent <u>other than the student regent</u> is six years, with the terms of <u>two or</u> three regents<u>, as applicable</u>, expiring every two years.

21 (b) The student regent holds office for a term of one year
22 expiring February 1, with the term of the initial student regent
23 expiring February 1, 2012.

24 (c) A regent [Members of the board] may be removed from
 25 office for inefficiency or malfeasance of office.

26 (d) Any vacancy that occurs on the board shall be filled by
 27 the governor for the unexpired term.

SECTION 11. Sections 106.11 and 106.12, Education Code, are
amended to read as follows:

3 Sec. 106.11. BOARD OF REGENTS. (a) The government of the 4 university is vested in a board of nine regents appointed by the 5 governor with the advice and consent of the <u>senate</u> [Senate].

6 (b) One of the regents must be a student regent serving 7 under Section 51.356.

8 Sec. 106.12. TERMS OF OFFICE. <u>(a)</u> Members of the board 9 <u>other than the student regent</u> hold office for staggered terms of six 10 years, with the terms of <u>two or</u> three <u>regents</u>, <u>as applicable</u>, 11 [<u>directors</u>] expiring [on] February 1 of odd-numbered years.

12 (b) The student regent holds office for a term of one year 13 expiring February 1, with the term of the initial student regent 14 expiring February 1, 2012.

15 SECTION 12. Section 107.21, Education Code, is amended to 16 read as follows:

Sec. 107.21. BOARD OF REGENTS. <u>(a)</u> The board of regents of the university is composed of nine persons[, four of whom shall be women,] appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the senate. <u>Four of the regents must be women.</u>

21 (b) One of the regents must be a student regent serving 22 <u>under Section 51.356.</u>

23 (c) Each regent other than the student regent must [Each 24 member of the board shall] be a qualified voter.

25 (d) The regents [+ and the members] shall be selected from 26 different portions of the state.

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(e) The <u>regents other than the student regent</u> [members] hold

1 office for staggered terms of six years, with the terms of two or 2 three regents, as applicable, expiring February 1 of odd-numbered 3 years.

4 (f) The student regent holds office for a term of one year
5 expiring February 1, with the term of the initial student regent
6 expiring February 1, 2012.

7 SECTION 13. Sections 109.21 and 109.22, Education Code, are 8 amended to read as follows:

9 Sec. 109.21. BOARD OF REGENTS. (a) The government, 10 control, and direction of the policies of the university are vested 11 in a board of nine regents[, who shall be] appointed by the governor 12 with the advice and consent of the senate.

13 (b) One of the regents must be a student regent serving 14 <u>under Section 51.355.</u>

15 Sec. 109.22. BOARD MEMBERS: TERMS, VACANCIES. (a) The regents other than the student regent [Except for the initial 16 17 appointees, members] hold office for [of] terms of six years expiring [on] January 31 of odd-numbered years[. In making the 18 19 initial appointments, the governor shall designate three for terms expiring in 1971, three for terms expiring in 1973, and three for 20 terms expiring in 1975]. 21

22 (b) The student regent holds office for a term of one year
23 expiring February 1, with the term of the initial student regent
24 expiring February 1, 2012.

25 (c) Any vacancy shall be filled for the unexpired portion of 26 the term by appointment by the governor with the advice and consent 27 of the senate.

1 SECTION 14. Section 111.12, Education Code, is amended to 2 read as follows:

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3 Sec. 111.12. APPOINTMENTS TO BOARD; TERMS. (a) The regents
4 [Members of the board] are appointed by the governor with the advice
5 and consent of the senate.

6 (b) One of the regents must be a student regent serving 7 <u>under Section 51.355.</u>

8 (c) The term of office of each regent <u>other than the student</u> 9 <u>regent</u> shall be six years[, except that in making the first 10 appointments the governor shall appoint three members for six 11 years, three members for four years, and three members for two 12 years].

13 (d) The student regent holds office for a term of one year 14 expiring February 1, with the term of the initial student regent 15 expiring February 1, 2012.

(e) Any vacancy that occurs on the board shall be filled for
 the unexpired term by appointment of the governor.

SECTION 15. (a) When the terms of members of the board of regents of a state university system expire February 1, 2011, one of the resulting vacancies on that board shall be filled by a student regent as provided by Section 51.355, Education Code, as amended by this Act, for a term expiring February 1, 2012, and the other two vacancies shall be filled for six-year terms as otherwise provided by law.

(b) When the terms of members of the board of regents of a state university expire February 1, 2011, one of the resulting vacancies on that board shall be filled by a student regent as

1 provided by Section 51.356, Education Code, as amended by this Act, 2 for a term expiring February 1, 2012, and the other two vacancies 3 shall be filled for six-year terms as otherwise provided by law.

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4 SECTION 16. The term of a nonvoting student regent 5 appointed before the effective date of this Act to serve for a state 6 university system or a state university for a term expiring May 1, 7 2011, expires on the date a voting student regent is appointed under 8 Section 51.355 or 51.356, Education Code, as amended by this Act, to 9 the board of regents of the system or university, as applicable.

10 SECTION 17. This Act does not affect the term of a member of 11 a board of regents of a state university system or a state 12 university serving on the effective date of this Act.

13 SECTION 18. The changes in law made by this Act to Sections 14 51.355(d-1) and 51.356(e-1), Education Code, apply only to a 15 student regent appointed to the board of regents of a state 16 university system or a state university on or after the effective 17 date of this Act.

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SECTION 19. This Act takes effect September 1, 2010.
