- 5 SECTION 1. Section 545.425, Transportation Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 545.425. USE OF WIRELESS COMMUNICATION DEVICE [BY
- 8 CERTAIN MOTORISTS]. (a) An operator [A person] may not use a
- 9 wireless communication device while operating a passenger bus with
- 10 a minor passenger on the bus except in case of emergency or if the
- 11 passenger bus is <u>stopped</u> [not in motion].
- 12 (b) An operator may not use a wireless communication device
- 13 to read, write, or send a text message while operating a motor
- 14 vehicle unless the vehicle is stopped. This subsection does not

- (1) the operator is a peace officer or an emergency

- 18 (2) the use of the wireless communication device is in

- 20 <u>(c) An offense under Subsection (b) is punishable by a fine</u>
- 21 of not less than \$2 or more than \$400 if the person who commits the

- 24 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only

- 1 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 2 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 3 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and
- 4 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 5 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 6 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was
- 7 committed before that date.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
