- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 25.0023, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (b) Notwithstanding any other law and in addition to the
- 9 judge's annual salary, the commissioners court annually shall pay a
- 10 judge of a statutory probate court who has continuously served as a
- 11 judge of a statutory probate court or a statutory county court since
- 12 August 31, 1995, an additional amount equal to the amount of benefit
- 13 replacement pay a district judge is entitled to receive from the
- 14 state under Subchapter H, Chapter 659, for equivalent continuous
- 15 <u>service</u> [The salary shall be paid in equal monthly installments].
- 16 <u>(c) The commissioners court monthly shall pay a statutory</u>
- 17 probate court judge who has served as a judge of a statutory probate
- 18 court or a statutory county court for at least 16 years longevity
- 19 pay in an amount equal to the amount of longevity pay a district
- 20 judge is entitled to receive from the state for equivalent years of
- 21 service. The longevity pay is in addition to the judge's monthly
- 22 salary.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
