Section 54.203, Education Code, is amended by 5 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-2) to read as 6 follows: 7 The exemptions provided for in Subsection (a) [of this 8 (b) 9 section] also apply [and inure] to [the benefit of]: (1) the children of <u>a member</u> [members] of the armed 10 11 forces of the United States: 12 (A) who was [are or were] killed in action; 13 who [die or] died while in service; (B) 14 (C) who is [are] missing in action; whose death is documented to be directly 15 (D) 16 caused by illness or injury connected with service in the armed forces of the United States; or 17 18 (E) who became totally disabled for purposes of employability according to the disability ratings of the Department 19 20 of Veterans Affairs as a result of a service-related injury; and 21 (2) the [orphans or] children and the current or surviving spouse of a member [members] of the Texas National Guard 22 and the Texas Air National Guard who: 23 was [were] killed since January 1, 1946, 24 (A)

1 while on active duty either in the service of this [their] state or the United States; or 2 3 (B) is [are] totally disabled for purposes of employability according to the disability ratings of the Department 4 5 of Veterans Affairs, regardless of whether the member is [members are] eligible to receive disability benefits from the department, 6 as a result of a service-related injury suffered since January 1, 7 8 1946, while on active duty either in the service of this state or the United States. 9

10 (b-2) The eligibility of a spouse under Subsection (b) for an exemption provided for in Subsection (a) expires on the earlier 11 12 of: 13 (1) the date the spouse remarries; or 14 (2) the 10th anniversary of: 15 (A) the date of the death of the member of the Texas National Guard or the Texas Air National Guard, as 16 17 applicable; or (B) the date the member was initially 18 19 determined to be totally disabled as described by Subsection 20 (b)(2)(B).

21 SECTION 2. Section 54.203, Education Code, as amended by 22 this Act, applies beginning with tuition and other fees charged for 23 the first term or semester that begins after the effective date of 24 this Act, but not earlier than the 2009 fall semester. Tuition and 25 other fees charged for an academic period before that term or 26 semester are covered by the law in effect immediately before the 27 effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in

1 effect for that purpose.

2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
