- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 363.301(a) and (b), Local Government
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The district is dissolved on the <u>first uniform election</u>
- 8 date that occurs after the fifth anniversary of the date the
- 9 district began to levy taxes for district purposes if the district
- 10 has not held a continuation or dissolution referendum.
- 11 (b) The district is dissolved on the first uniform election
- 12 <u>date that occurs after the</u> fifth anniversary of the date of the most
- 13 recent continuation or dissolution referendum.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
