- (ii)  $\underline{\text{five}}$  [10] percent of that total vote.

24 (a) To be entitled to have the names of its nominees placed

- 1 on the general election ballot, a political party required to make

- SECTION 3. Section 181.006(b), Election Code, is amended to

- 20 (3) be filed with the secretary of state by the state
- 21 chair before the deadline for filing the lists of precinct
