## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to a grant available to school districts to provide 3 services to students with disabilities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 29, Education Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 29.018 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 29.018. SPECIAL EDUCATION GRANT. (a) From funds
- 8 appropriated for the purposes of this section, federal funds, or
- 9 any other funds available, the commissioner shall make grants
- 10 <u>available to school districts to assist districts in covering the</u>
- 11 cost of educating students with disabilities.
- (b) A school district is eligible to apply for a grant under
- 13 this section if:

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- 14 (1) the district does not receive sufficient funds,
- 15 including state funds provided under Section 42.151 and federal
- 16 funds, for a student with disabilities to pay for the special
- 17 education services provided to the student; or
- 18 (2) the district does not receive sufficient funds,
- 19 including state funds provided under Section 42.151 and federal
- 20 funds, for all students with disabilities in the district to pay for
- 21 the special education services provided to the students.
- (c) A school district that applies for a grant under this
- 23 section must provide the commissioner with a report comparing the
- 24 state and federal funds received by the district for students with

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- 1 disabilities and the expenses incurred by the district in providing
- 2 special education services to students with disabilities.
- 3 (d) Expenses that may be included by a school district in
- 4 applying for a grant under this section include the cost of training
- 5 personnel to provide special education services to a student with
- 6 <u>disabilities</u>.
- 7 (e) A school district that receives a grant under this
- 8 section must educate students with disabilities in the least
- 9 restrictive environment that is appropriate to meet the student's
- 10 <u>educational needs</u>.
- 11 (f) The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to
- 12 administer this section.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2009-2010
- 14 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
