## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the deadline for a school district to file a complaint
- 3 concerning a student who fails to attend school without excuse.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 25.0951(a), Education Code, as amended
- 6 by Chapters 908 (H.B. 2884) and 984 (S.B. 1161), Acts of the 80th
- 7 Legislature, Regular Session, 2007, is reenacted and amended to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 (a) If a student fails to attend school without excuse on 10
- 10 or more days or parts of days within a six-month period in the same
- 11 school year, a school district shall within  $\underline{14}$  [ $\underline{10}$ ] school days of
- 12 the student's 10th absence:
- 13 (1) file a complaint against the student or the
- 14 student's parent or both in a county, justice, or municipal court
- 15 for an offense under Section 25.093 or 25.094, as appropriate, or
- 16 refer the student to a juvenile court in a county with a population
- 17 of less than 100,000 for conduct that violates Section 25.094; or
- 18 (2) refer the student to a juvenile court for conduct
- 19 indicating a need for supervision under Section 51.03(b)(2), Family
- 20 Code.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
