## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the authority of certain school districts to lay fiber
- 3 optic cable in county rights-of-way.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 11, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 11.172 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 11.172. USE OF COUNTY RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR FIBER OPTIC
- 8 CABLE. (a) This section applies only to a school district any part
- 9 of which is located 60 miles or less from an international border.
- 10 (b) A school district may place in any county right-of-way
- 11 fiber optic cable necessary or convenient for a facility of the
- 12 district to receive telecommunications services or to communicate
- 13 with other facilities of the district.
- 14 (c) A school district, in placing fiber optic cable under
- 15 this section, shall coordinate with the county in whose
- 16 right-of-way the district intends to place the cable to ensure that
- 17 the district's cable does not interfere with the property or
- 18 facilities of the county or of a utility using the right-of-way.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
