6	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 419, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 419.0342 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 419.0342. LIMITATION ON INFORMATION REQUIRED FOR
9	CERTIFICATE RENEWAL. The requirements and procedures adopted by
10	the commission for the renewal of a certificate issued under this
11	subchapter:
12	(1) may not require an applicant to provide unchanged
13	information already included in one or more of the applicant's
14	previous applications for certification or for certificate renewal
15	filed with the commission; and
16	(2) may require the applicant to provide only
17	information relevant to the period occurring since the date of the
18	applicant's last application for certification or for certificate
19	renewal, as applicable, including information relevant to any new
20	requirement applicable to the certificate held by the applicant.
21	SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 773, Health and Safety
22	Code, is amended by adding Section 773.0415 to read as follows:
23	Sec. 773.0415. LIMITATION ON INFORMATION REQUIRED FOR
24	CERTIFICATE RENEWAL. The requirements and procedures adopted by

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1	the department for the renewal of a certificate to practice as
2	emergency medical services personnel issued under this chapter:
3	(1) may not require an applicant to provide unchanged
4	information already included in one or more of the applicant's
5	previous applications for certification or for certificate renewal
6	filed with the department; and
7	(2) may require the applicant to provide only
8	information relevant to the period occurring since the date of the
9	applicant's last application for certification or for certificate
10	renewal, as applicable, including information relevant to any new
11	requirement applicable to the certificate held by the applicant.
12	SECTION 3. Subchapter G, Chapter 1701, Occupations Code, is
13	amended by adding Section 1701.317 to read as follows:
14	Sec. 1701.317. LIMITATION ON INFORMATION REQUIRED FOR
15	LICENSE RENEWAL. The requirements and procedures adopted by the
16	commission for the renewal of a license issued under this chapter:
17	(1) may not require an applicant to provide unchanged
18	information already included in one or more of the applicant's
19	previous applications for licensure or for license renewal filed
20	with the commission; and
21	(2) may require the applicant to provide only
22	information relevant to the period occurring since the date of the
23	applicant's last application for licensure or for license renewal,
24	as applicable, including information relevant to any new
25	requirement applicable to the license held by the applicant.
26	SECTION 4. Sections 419.0342, Government Code, 773.0415,
27	Health and Safety Code, and 1701.317, Occupations Code, as added by

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this Act, apply only to a license or certificate renewed on or after
January 1, 2011.

3 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
