A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the expansion of services provided under the child
- 3 health plan program for certain adolescents.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 62.151, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended by amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (c-1) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (c) In developing the plan, the commission, except as
- 9 provided by Subsection (c-1), shall ensure that primary and
- 10 preventive health benefits do not include reproductive services,
- 11 other than prenatal care and care related to diseases, illnesses,
- 12 or abnormalities related to the reproductive system.
- 13 <u>(c-1)</u> The commission shall ensure that an enrolled
- 14 adolescent who is at least 16 years of age has access to
- 15 comprehensive family planning services, except services related to
- 16 abortion or emergency contraception, as a covered benefit if the
- 17 adolescent already has at least one child.
- SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 19 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 20 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 21 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 22 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 23 waiver or authorization is granted.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
