## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to referral of public school students to law enforcement
- 3 officials for violations of an independent school district student
- 4 code of conduct.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 37, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 37.023 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 37.023. LIMITATION ON REFERRAL TO LAW ENFORCEMENT
- 9 OFFICIAL FOR VIOLATION OF STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT. A school
- 10 administrator may not refer a student to a law enforcement official
- 11 on the basis of conduct by the student that violates the school
- 12 district's student code of conduct but that the administrator knows
- 13 <u>or has reason to know is not a criminal offense.</u>
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
