- 11 (b) The court shall give notice of the date of a hearing in a

- 13 105.0031.
- 14 SECTION 2. Chapter 105, Family Code, is amended by adding
- 15 Section 105.0031 to read as follows:
- Sec. 105.0031. NOTICE OF HEARING DATE. (a) This section
- 17 applies only to a court in a county with a population of one million
- 18 <u>or more.</u>
- 19 (b) After a hearing date on a petition or motion in a
- 20 proceeding filed under this title is set, the court shall promptly
- 21 give written notice of the hearing date to the petitioner or movant.
- (c) Notwithstanding Section 22.004, Government Code, the
- 23 supreme court may not amend or adopt rules in conflict with this
- 24 section.

- 1 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 2 to a petition or motion filed on or after the effective date of this
- 3 Act. A petition or motion filed before that date is governed by the
- 4 law in effect immediately before that date, and the former law is
- 5 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
