- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 521.249, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (a) Not later than the 10th day after the date the court
- 9 signs an order granting an occupational license to a person, the
- 10 [The] court shall send:
- 11 (1) a certified copy of the petition and the court
- 12 order setting out the judge's findings and restrictions to the
- 13 department; and
- 14 (2) a copy of the order to the person.
- 15 (a-1) The person may use a copy of the order as a restricted
- 16 license until the 31st day after the date on which the order takes
- 17 effect.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
