Section 20(b), Article 42.12, Code of Criminal Procedure, is amended to read as follows: 7 (b) This section does not apply to: 8 (1) a defendant convicted of an offense [under 9 Sections 49.04-49.08, Penal Code, a defendant convicted of an 10 11 offense] for which on conviction registration as a sex offender is 12 required under Chapter 62; $[\tau]$ or 13 (2) a defendant convicted of a felony described by 14 Section 3g. SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a 15 defendant who is placed on community supervision before, on, or 16 after the effective date of this Act. 17 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
