- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- 6 SECTION 1. Subtitle A, Title 3, Government Code, is amended
- 7 by adding Chapter 307 to read as follows:
- CHAPTER 307. ELIGIBILITY TO LEGISLATURE 8
- Sec. 307.001. INELIGIBILITY OF PERSONS HOLDING OTHER 9
- OFFICES. (a) A judge of any court, the secretary of state, the 10
- attorney general, the clerk of any court of record, or any other 11
- person holding a lucrative office under the United States, this 12
- state, including a political subdivision of this state, or any 13
- 14 foreign government is ineligible to serve in the legislature during
- the term for which the person is elected or appointed. 15
- (b) The ineligibility provided by Subsection (a) applies to 16
- the entire term to which the office holder was elected or appointed 17
- and is not affected by the office holder's resignation or removal 18
- from office before the end of the term. 19
- (c) For purposes of Subsection (a), an office is lucrative 20
- 21 if the office holder is entitled to receive any salary, fee,
- reimbursement, or other compensation, no matter how small. 22
- 23 (d) A person who is ineligible to serve in the legislature
- 24 under this section may not file an application for a place on the

- 1 ballot as a candidate for the legislature for a legislative term
- 2 during which the ineligibility applies for any portion of the term.
- 3 An application filed in violation of this subsection is invalid.
- 4 Sec. 307.002. PROHIBITION ON PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT BY
- 5 LEGISLATOR. (a) A member of the legislature may not, during the
- 6 term for which the member is elected, be simultaneously employed in
- 7 any position under the United States, this state, including a
- 8 political subdivision of this state, or any foreign government.
- 9 (b) For purposes of this section, "office" does not include:
- 10 (1) a notary public; or
- 11 (2) a position in the armed forces reserve of the
- 12 United States or this state.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
