- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 411.122, Government Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (b) to read as follows:
- (b) A municipality or county that requires a sexually 8
- 9 oriented business to obtain a license or other permit under Section
- 243.007, Local Government Code, is entitled to obtain from the 10
- department criminal history record information maintained by the 11
- 12 department that relates to a person who:
- 13 (1) is an applicant for a license or other permit for a
- 14 sexually oriented business issued by the municipality or county;
- (2) is the holder of a license or other permit for a 15
- sexually oriented business issued by the municipality or county; or 16
- (3) requests a determination of eligibility for a 17
- license or other permit for a sexually oriented business issued by 18
- 19 the municipality or county.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 22
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- Act takes effect September 1, 2009. 24
