- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 411.122, Government Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 8 (b) A municipality or county that requires a sexually
- 9 oriented business to obtain a license or other permit under Section
- 10 243.007, Local Government Code, is entitled to obtain from the
- 11 department criminal history record information maintained by the
- 12 <u>department that relates to a person who:</u>
- 13 (1) is an applicant for a license or other permit from
- 14 the municipality or county;
- 15 (2) is the holder of a license or other permit from the
- 16 municipality or county; or
- 17 (3) requests a determination of eligibility for a
- 18 license or other permit from the municipality or county.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
