- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 504.202(b) and (g), Transportation
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) A veteran of the United States armed forces is entitled
- 8 to register, for the person's own use, \underline{a} [two] motor vehicle
- 9 [vehicles] under this section if:
- 10 (1) the person has suffered, as a result of military
- 11 service:
- 12 (A) at least a 50 percent service-connected
- 13 disability; or
- 14 (B) a 40 percent service-connected disability
- 15 because of the amputation of a lower extremity;
- 16 (2) the person receives compensation from the United
- 17 States because of the disability; and
- 18 (3) the motor vehicle:
- 19 (A) is owned by the person; and
- 20 (B) has a manufacturer's rated carrying capacity
- 21 of two tons or less.
- 22 (g) A person who receives [two sets of] license plates under
- 23 this section may receive <u>a</u> [two] disabled parking <u>placard</u>
- 24 [placards] under Section 681.004 for each set of license plates

- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
