- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 84, Family Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Section 84.006 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 84.006. CONFERRING WITH CHILD. If a party in a
- 8 proceeding under this title files a motion requesting the court to
- 9 confer with a child who is a member of the family or household for
- 10 which protection is sought or on whose behalf the application for a
- 11 protective order is made, the court shall confer with the child in
- 12 chambers before the hearing on the application for a protective
- 13 order.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 84.006, Family Code, as added by this
- 15 Act, applies to a hearing on an application for a protective order
- 16 held on or after the effective date of this Act, regardless of the
- 17 date the application is filed.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
